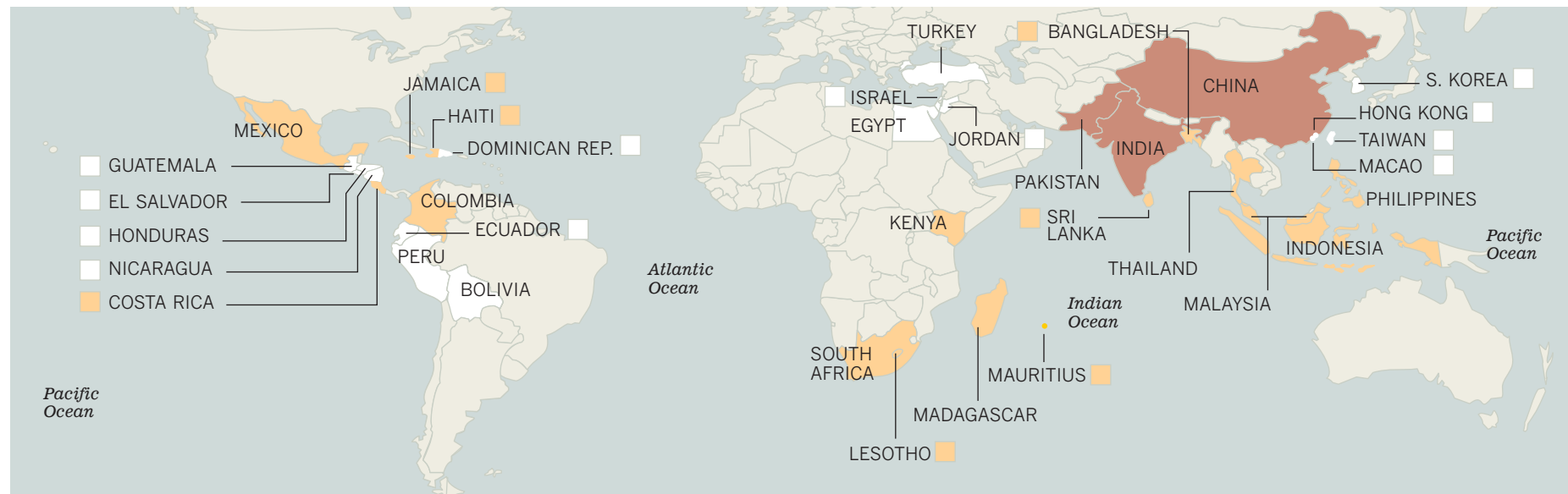


Shifting textile and apparel production
