Administration, library, conservation labs, training classrooms, conference rooms

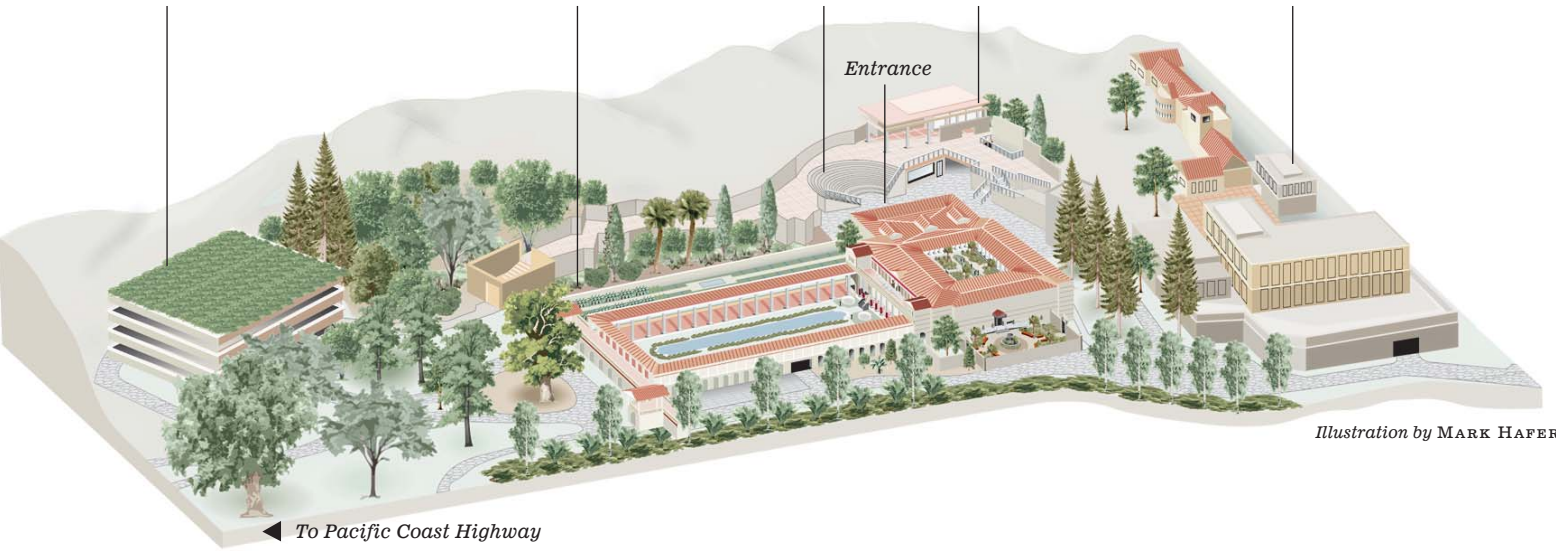
