In your letter of May 5, 1971, you attached an information sheet entitled "Allegations of War Crimes Other than Son My." I would like to request additional information elaborating upon the statistics cited in that information sheet, including:

1. An individual case breakdown of those convicted by Court Martial; a description of charges brought against these individuals and charges for which defendants were convicted; an individual breakdown as to sentences imposed by the military court and time actually served in prison.

2. A listing and description of the cases in which commissioned officers were acquitted.

3. A status report on the investigations now in progress relating to alleged war crimes.

I would like this information as soon as possible.
